The Valley Hunt Club is an historic Colonial Revival building designed by architect Myron Hunt in 1907. Original California *en plein* air paintings are exhibited throughout the club. Members of the Valley Hunt Club founded the Rose Parade in 1890, and the club continues to participate with an historic coach decorated with flowers each year.

Parking:

Complimentary Parking is on site at VHC. Enter from Orange Grove Boulevard just south of Palmetto.

Dress Code:

The Valley Hunt Club is a private members-only club with a strict dress code. Men must wear dress pants, collared shirts, sport coat, blazer, or suit. Jackets must be worn at all times.
